Day 1: W Trusting God's Sovereignty

Your Verse

Jeremiah 29:11 – "For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

Supporting Scriptures

- Proverbs 3:5 "Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;"
- Romans 8:28 "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."







Day 1: W Trusting God's Sovereignty

Devotional: Finding Peace in God's Plan

The empty nest can feel uncertain and even unsettling, but God's sovereignty remains unchanged. Jeremiah 29:11 reminds us that God has good plans for us, even when life shifts in unexpected ways. Trusting Him means believing that the next season has a purpose designed by the Creator who knows us intimately.

Devotional: Welcoming God's New Work in Life

Life is marked by seasons, each with its own purpose and beauty. Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us that change is not only inevitable but ordained by God. The empty nest season signals a shift from one chapter to another—a moment to embrace God's new work in your life.

Day 3: V Love That Endures









Your Verse

1 Corinthians 13:7 – "It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."

Supporting Scriptures

- John 13:34 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another."
- Romans 12:10 "Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves."







Devotional: Love's Enduring Strength in Empty Nest

Though children grow and leave home, the love of a parent endures forever. Paul's description of love in 1 Corinthians 13 teaches us that true love never fades but continues to protect, trust, hope, and persevere.

As the empty nest brings change, parents are invited to continue loving with patience and grace, trusting God's ongoing work in their children's lives. This love extends beyond physical presence, rooted deeply in prayer and faith.

Consider today how your love can transition and thrive in new ways, continuing to nurture relationships even at a distance.







Reflect and Apply

1.	How has my love for my children changed or matured in this season?
2.	In what ways can I continue to demonstrate love despite physical distance?
3.	How does God's example of love inspire my parenting now?







Journaling Prompts

1.	Recall a time when enduring love brought you comfort or strength.
2.	Write a letter of love and blessing to your child reflecting this season.
3.	List practical ways to express and deepen love after children leave home.







Prayer for Today

Lord Jesus, thank You for teaching us what true love looks like. Help me to love my children with the same enduring faithfulness, even when they are far away. May my love reflect Your grace, patience, and hope. Strengthen me to persevere in prayer and kindness, trusting You to guide and protect them. *In Your precious name, Amen.*

















Your Verse

Isaiah 40:31 – "But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."
- Philippians 4:13 "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."







Devotional: Renewed Strength from God's Presence

Transitions can be exhausting, but God offers renewal and strength to all who hope in Him. Isaiah 40:31 gives a picture of soaring on eagle's wings, a beautiful metaphor for rising above weariness through God's power.

Whether facing feelings of loneliness, loss, or uncertainty about purpose, parents can find refuge in God's strength. He is present, ready to uphold and refresh your spirit when human energy runs thin.

Today focus on seeking God's strength through prayer and trust. Invite Him to renew your energy and hope as you move forward in faith.

2.	How can I intentionally place my hope in God's renewing strength?
3.	What spiritual practices help me connect with God's power?







Journaling Prompts

1.	Write about a time God renewed your strength in a difficult season.
2.	List ways you can seek God's refuge daily.
	Reflect on how trusting God's strength changes your perspective on challenges.







Prayer for Today

Father God, I come to You feeling weary and uncertain. Renew my strength and fill me with hope as I trust in You. Help me to soar above discouragement and find refuge in Your presence.
