Devotional: Identify and Celebrate Unique Gifts Early

Every child is uniquely gifted by the Holy Spirit. Recognizing these gifts early allows you to nurture their calling and confidence. Paul reminds us that spiritual gifts vary, but all are empowered by the same Spirit for God's kingdom.

Listen attentively to your grandchildren's interests, talents, and joy in serving. Pray for discernment to identify the spiritual gifts God is cultivating within them. Even small areas of enthusiasm may indicate a budding gift — creativity, encouragement, hospitality, or leadership.

Celebrate and encourage these gifts with kind words and opportunities to serve in family, church, or community contexts. Helping grandchildren understand that their skills are God-given reassures their purpose and identity in Christ. Nurture their calling with patience, affirmations, and prayerful guidance.
