Devotional: God's Nearness to the Brokenhearted

When the weight of despair presses down, it can feel like you are utterly alone. Yet, God's Word reminds us with tender compassion that He is nearest to the brokenhearted. Psalm 34:18 assures us that the Lord is not distant—He draws close when we are crushed in spirit. *This means your pain is seen, your tears noticed, and your heart held in His caring hands.*

Perhaps today is filled with heavy thoughts, but God's presence is a refuge you can turn to again and again. He does not promise we won't feel pain, but He promises to be with us inside it. He saves and sustains those who call on Him.

Hold on to hope by leaning into this truth: You are deeply loved by God, even in your darkest hours. Your suffering does not define you—His love does.

For women wrestling with despair, Ruth teaches us that hope is found not only in circumstances but in choosing to cling to God and supportive community. *This kind of hope fuels resilience and renewal one day at a time.*

When the weight of pain tempts you to quit, remember that God honors faithfulness—even when the answers seem slow. *He encourages us to keep holding on with patient hope.*

Let today be a reminder to persist in faith, trusting God's perfect timing and justice.
