Introduction

Day 1: SEmbracing Christ's Peace

Your Verse

John 14:27 NIV - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

Supporting Scriptures

- Philippians 4:7 "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
- Isaiah 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."







Day 1: SEmbracing Christ's Peace

Devotional: Christ Gives a Peace That Overcomes Fear

Peace is not just the absence of trouble; it is a deep assurance that God is in control. Jesus knew His disciples would face fear and uncertainty, especially after He left. So He gave them a promise: His peace—a peace unlike anything the world offers.

When we step into evangelism, moments of fear and doubt can rush in. But Jesus assures us that His peace can calm the storm inside. This peace guards our hearts and minds, keeping us steady amidst rejection, ridicule, or self-doubt.

To share the gospel boldly, we must first embrace the peace Christ provides. This means trusting that He equips our words and actions and that He is ultimately at work, even when we face challenges.

Today, receive Jesus' peace and remember: you are never alone when you share the Good News.

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."
- Ephesians 6:19 "Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel."







Devotional: Holy Spirit Empowers Fearless Witness

Evangelism can feel intimidating, but we are not left to our own strength.Jesus promised the Holy Spirit would come to empower us, transforming fear into boldness.

When filled with the Spirit, our witness becomes fueled by divine power—enabling us to speak clearly, love deeply, and stay disciplined in our mission. This boldness is not brashness; it is the confidence that comes from knowing God is working through us.

Paul's prayers for fearless speech remind us to lean heavily into the Spirit's power. Instead of shrinking back, we can stand firm, knowing the Spirit equips our words and hearts.

Invite the Holy Spirit to fill you anew today, and watch fear give way to bold and joyful witness.

Your Verse

1 John 4:18 NIV – "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love."

Supporting Scriptures

- John 13:34 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another."
- Romans 8:15 "The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship, by whom we cry, 'Abba, Father.'"







Devotional: Perfect Love Frees Us From Fear

Fear often hinders our ability to love fully in evangelism. But Scripture teaches us that perfect love casts out fear.

When we focus on Jesus' love flowing through us, fear loses its grip. Loving others as Christ loves us means offering the gospel out of genuine care, not out of pressure or condemnation.

True evangelism flows from a heart confident in God's love, which replaces fear with compassion. We don't share because we are afraid, but because we want to see others embraced by God's grace.

Let love be your motivation to share the good news boldly and without fear today.

Devotional: God's Strength Sustains You Amid Opposition

Sharing the gospel often invites opposition and rejection. Yet God's Spirit within us equips us with power, love, and self-discipline to face these challenges without fear.

Jesus reassures His followers that when they encounter difficult moments, God will provide the right words and peace to stand firm.

Remember, God is on your side — no opposition can defeat His purposes or His peace in you. When you encounter resistance in evangelism, lean on the Spirit's strength and maintain a heart rooted in love.

Trust God's presence fueling your witness in every circumstance today.

Devotional: Reflect Christ's Peace as a Witness
