Devotional: Trusting God's Perfect Timing in Singleness

Devotional: Living Out Your True Identity in Christ

Galatians 2:20 reveals a powerful truth: as believers, our old selves are gone, and now **Christ lives in us.** This means your worth is not defined by singleness or pairing but by being God's beloved child.

John 1:12 reminds us that accepting Christ grants us the right to become children of God. This foundational truth transforms how we view ourselves and our purpose. In every season, including singleness, you are *God's handiwork*, crafted intentionally for good works (Ephesians 2:10).

Embracing your identity in Christ empowers you to live confidently and with peace, free from societal pressures. Instead of chasing external validation, focus on the eternal value God has placed in you.

Devotional: Choosing Contentment in God's Strength

Contentment is one of the most valuable gifts we can cultivate during singleness. Paul's words in Philippians 4:11-13 show us a life anchored in Christ where true contentment is possible even amid challenges. His secret? Dependence on Christ's strength.

1 Timothy 6:6 highlights that godliness combined with contentment is great gain — not because of external circumstances but because we know God is sufficient for all our needs. When we find our joy and fulfillment in Him, singleness becomes a season rich with meaning and peace.

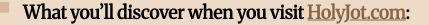
