#### Devotional: God's Gift of Lasting Peace

#### Devotional: Learning to Rest in God's Sovereign Plan

**Trust is a critical ingredient in living with peace in your calling.** Jeremiah's assurance that God has plans for our welfare and hope is a foundational promise to cling to when the path seems unclear. Trusting God means believing that every step He leads us to is designed for our good and His glory.

All too often, our own understanding tempts us to doubt and worry, especially when life's situations appear confusing or disappointing. However, Scripture reminds us to surrender our limited viewpoint and acknowledge God's sovereignty in guiding our steps. #### Devotional: God's Spirit Replaces Fear with Courage
