#### Devotional: Letting Humility Build Team Peace

Hebrews emphasizes the importance of spurring each other to love and good deeds, creating a culture where kindness and support outshine competition. Even small words of encouragement can lift heavy hearts and shift attitudes.

When teammates focus on cheering one another instead of criticizing, anxiety and conflict diminish. This positive environment strengthens trust and cooperation, key ingredients of a peaceful team culture.

#### Devotional: Conflict Resolution Builds Lasting Peace

Conflicts are inevitable, but how we handle them can bring peace or division. Jesus instructs us to address offenses privately and lovingly, aiming for reconciliation. This practice protects relationships and upholds team unity.

Ephesians highlights the importance of removing bitterness and responding with kindness and forgiveness—the foundation for lasting peace. Colossians similarly calls us to patience and bearing with one another.

In a sports context, resolving conflicts graciously prevents grudges that can fracture teams. Approaching teammates with humility and a goal to restore, not accuse, reflects God's heart and promotes harmony.

Commit to becoming a peacemaker who confronts conflict with grace, encouraging your team to grow stronger through forgiveness and understanding.
