Devotional: Start with Trust: God's Peace Protects

Your Verse

Devotional: Integrity: The Marketplace Shield

Integrity protects and guides us like a shield in the marketplace. Proverbs 11:3 reminds us that upright conduct leads us on the right path, but duplicity—double-dealing or dishonesty—brings destruction. In business, integrity means honoring commitments, being transparent, and avoiding shortcuts, even when no one is watching.

Devotional: Upholding Justice and Fairness in Business
