Psalm 32:3-5 NIV - "When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long... Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity..."

- Proverbs 28:13 "Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy."

#### Devotional: Hidden Burdens Fade When We Confess

We all carry burdens, but hidden sins and unspoken struggles weigh heaviest. Psalm 32 captures the deep pain that silence can bring, describing how the psalmist's bones wasted away from the anguish of keeping sin inside. When we hide our faults, shame isolates us, and stress grips our spirit.

Yet there is a hopeful turning point. Acknowledging and confessing our sin opens the door to mercy and healing. Concealment may feel safer momentarily, but true relief comes through transparency before God and trusted others.
