Your Verse

John 14:27 - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Philippians 4:7 - "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."*
- *Isaiah 26:3 - "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."*



Devotional: Embracing Jesus' Gift of Peace

Jesus promises a peace unlike any other. Worldly peace is often fragile, dependent on circumstances, but Jesus offers a deep, abiding peace that protects our hearts from fear. This peace is a gift—freely given and meant to be accepted.

But what does this peace look like in everyday life? It's more than calmness; it's a steadfastness rooted in trust. Trust that God is in control. Trust that serving others is part of reflecting His love.

When we embrace peace at its source, our hearts can overflow with the desire to serve others—not out of obligation, but as an expression of that peace within us. Serving then becomes a channel for God's peace to flow through us, touching others and increasing the joy in our lives.

Your Verse

Mark 10:45 – "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Supporting Scriptures

- *John 13:14-15 – "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you."*
- *Galatians 5:13 – "...serve one another humbly in love."*



Day 2:  Serving as Jesus Served

Devotional: Following Jesus' Humble Example

Jesus is the ultimate model for serving others: He came not to be served but to serve selflessly and sacrificially. His humble act of washing His disciples' feet exemplifies love in action.

What would it look like for us to follow this example? Serving others with humility means setting aside pride and convenience to meet real needs with love. It's an invitation to share God's peace by becoming channels of His grace.

When we serve like Jesus, we reflect His heart and experience peace because our focus shifts from ourselves to the well-being of others. Our selfish worries diminish as we find joy in giving.

Your Verse

Acts 20:35 – "In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"

Supporting Scriptures

- *2 Corinthians 9:7 – "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."*
- *Proverbs 11:25 – "A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed."*



Day 3: 📁 Joy in Giving Freely

Devotional: Discovering Joy in Generous Giving

Giving is a source of joy that connects us to God's heart. When we give freely and cheerfully, we participate in God's work and find refreshment ourselves. The Lord reminds us it is more blessed to give than to receive, underscoring the deep satisfaction found in selfless generosity.

This joy isn't dependent on the size of the gift but on the heart behind it. Whether it's time, resources, or love, our giving reflects God's love and opens the door for His peace to fill our lives.

As you consider your own giving, allow joy to be your motivation. Supporting others strengthens communities and nurtures your soul, creating a cycle of blessing and peace.
