#### Devotional: Embracing Endurance in Tribulation

#### Devotional: Equipping Yourself with God's Armor

Facing tribulation requires more than human strength; it demands the full armor of God. Paul's letter to the Ephesians lays out essential pieces of this spiritual armor — truth, righteousness, the gospel of peace, faith, salvation, the Word, and prayer. These aren't metaphors; they are vital tools to withstand the enemy's attacks.

How do we put on this armor daily? It begins with surrender—recognizing our weaknesses and relying wholeheartedly on God's grace. His power shines brightest not through our self-sufficiency, but through our dependence on Him (2 Corinthians 12:9).

**Psalm 18 paints God as a fortress and deliverer,** reminding us of His protective presence. As we commit to clothe ourselves with His strength, our spirit is fortified against the battles in life and faith.

#### Devotional: Joy in the Refining Fire of Faith

**Trials aren't just hardships to endure, they are opportunities for growth.** Peter encourages believers to rejoice even in suffering, knowing their faith is being tested and purified like gold refined by fire. This refining process strengthens our character and deepens our hope.

Why is this refining necessary? Because it transforms superficial faith into mature, unshakable trust in God. James echoes this calling to joy amidst trials, highlighting that perseverance shapes our spiritual maturity.

**Romans reminds us** that suffering builds perseverance and ultimately fills us with hope that does not disappoint. As believers preparing for tribulation, embracing this refining fires builds resilience, courage, and an unbreakable bond with Christ.

#### Devotional: Courage to Proclaim Amid Trials
