Psalm 145:1-3 - "I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever. Every day I will praise you and extol your name for ever and ever. Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; his greatness no one can fathom."

- Isaiah 40:28 "Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth."
- Revelation 4:11 "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things."







Devotional: Embracing God's Majesty Through Daily Praise

Today, we set our hearts to recognize the majesty of God. Psalm 145 begins with a powerful declaration — a personal commitment to praise God forever. David emphasizes that God's greatness is beyond human understanding. It's a majesty that transcends time and space and invites awe.

Have you ever stopped to reflect on how vast and mighty God is? The psalmist reminds us that God is worthy of eternal praise, not just because of His power to create, but because of who He is — the everlasting King. Psalm 145:8-9 - "The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made."

Supporting Scriptures

- Lamentations 3:22–23 "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."
- Ephesians 2:4-5 "But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions."







Devotional: Reflecting on God's Compassion and Kindness

God's greatness is not only in His power but in His tender compassion and goodness. Today's verses from Psalm 145 highlight a God who is patient, loving, and kind — a refuge for the brokenhearted and those in need.

We often associate greatness with strength or might, but Psalm 145 reminds us that true greatness is also shown in mercy and grace. His compassion reaches each of us personally, even when we feel undeserving.

Consider how God's goodness unfolds daily around you: the new mercies each morning, the forgiveness extended when we fail, the patience that offers second chances. His love is not distant; it is deeply relational and persistent. As you reflect on this, let your heart respond to God's goodness with gratitude and praise. Recognize the ways He has shown you kindness and offer Him your thanks.
