Prayer offers safety to lay down burdens and to receive forgiveness—as Christ forgave us. Today, seek to pray earnestly for each other's wounds and release any bitterness or anger through God's grace. This builds a heart connection stronger than circumstance.

Devotional: Inviting God Into Our Day From Dawn

Beginning your day with prayer as a couple sets a tone of unity and dependence on God. Psalm 5 shows the psalmist's habit of pouring out requests first thing in the morning and waiting expectantly for God's guidance. This practice invites God to direct your steps and decisions.

Like Jesus rising early to pray, couples benefit from creating a morning rhythm of prayer—alone and together—to align hearts and minds before the busyness strikes. It cultivates peace, shared purpose, and helps you carry God's presence throughout your day.

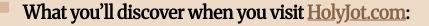
