Praying for God's Will Through Psalm 25



A 7-day study exploring Psalm 25 to seek God's guidance, mercy, and will in our lives through prayer and trust.





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Introduction

Your Verse

Psalm 25:4 NIV - "Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths."

Supporting Scriptures

- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart... He will make your paths straight."
- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God... and it will be given to you."







Devotional: Opening Our Hearts to Divine Guidance

Starting our journey, we focus on the earnest request David makes to God: "Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths." Here, David admits he does not have all the answers and appeals to God's wisdom and direction. Similarly, our lives often confront decisions and crossroads where clarity feels elusive.

To pray for God's will means opening ourselves to His instruction, recognizing that our understanding is limited. Proverbs reminds us to fully trust God to direct our paths, not relying on our own reasoning. This requires humility—a readiness to say, "I don't know, but You do." James encourages us to ask God for wisdom, promising that He gives generously without finding fault.

As you begin this study, ask God to reveal His ways to you. Listen for His voice, and be willing to follow where He leads, even if the path feels uncertain.

Psalm 25:6 NIV - "Remember, Lord, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old."

Supporting Scriptures

- Lamentations 3:22–23 "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail."
- Ephesians 2:4–5 "But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ."







Day 2: Confidence in God's Mercy

Devotional: Trusting God's Unfailing Mercy

Day 3: Seeking Protection in God's Care

Devotional: Hopeful Patience in God's Timing

Hope and patience go hand in hand in the life of faith. David's confidence that those who hope in God will not be disappointed encourages us to endure delays and uncertainties while trusting God's timing.

Psalm 25:7 NIV - "Do not remember the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you, Lord, are good."

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins."
- Isaiah 1:18 "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow."







Devotional: Experiencing Renewal Through Forgiveness

David confesses his past sins, asking God to remember him according to His love, not his rebellious deeds. For us, this highlights the power of forgiveness in aligning with God's will.

Holding onto guilt or shame can block our prayers and distort how we view God's plans for us. God offers restoration and a new start when we confess and turn to Him. His goodness and love override our mistakes, inviting us into renewed purpose.

Today, let go of past failures, receive God's forgiveness, and step forward restored and ready to pursue His will.

Devotional: Anchored in God's Loving Faithfulness


Concluding our study, we reflect on the assurance that God's paths are loving and faithful. As we seek to live according to His will, we find His covenant characterized by unfailing love.
