Day 1: A Embracing a Heart of Prayer

Devotional: Adopt a Consistent Prayer Habit

Your Verse

Supporting Scriptures

- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."
- Psalm 32:8 "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."







Devotional: Seeking Wisdom for Your Coworkers

Workplaces often require a clear mind and good judgment. As you pray for your coworkers, ask God to grant them wisdom to navigate decisions and challenges with clarity and integrity.

James encourages believers to seek God's wisdom generously without hesitation, trusting that He will provide. When you include your coworkers in such prayers, you are inviting God's guidance into their tasks, interactions, and long-term career paths.

Remember that God's wisdom often reflects His love and care, offering pathways that honor Him while benefiting everyone involved. Pray that God will illuminate their minds and open their hearts to His leading today.

- Ephesians 4:3 "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."







Devotional: Fostering Unity in the Workplace

Work environments often bring together diverse personalities and perspectives. Praying for unity among coworkers promotes peace and mutual respect that reflect God's heart.

Psalm 133 celebrates the blessing found in harmonious relationships. When you pray for unity, you petition God to soften hearts, reduce conflicts, and strengthen cooperation in the workplace.

Unity does not mean uniformity but a shared commitment to respect, understanding, and working well together. Today, ask the Holy Spirit to fill your workplace with a spirit of collaboration and goodwill.

- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 "But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one."
