# Devotional: Prayer for a Loving and Compassionate Heart

Beginning with love sets the foundation for every strong marriage. Today's scriptures remind us of the importance of humility, gentleness, and patience —all wrapped in the garment of love. As you pray for your spouse, ask God to cultivate these qualities deeply within their heart. #### Devotional: Prayer for God's Peace and Protection

#### Devotional: Prayer for Healing Emotional Wounds
