Day 1: K Foundation of Blessing

Devotional: Declaring God's Blessing Over Their Lives

Starting with God's Blessing is powerful when praying for your grandchildren. Numbers 6:24–26 is often called the priestly blessing and is a perfect foundation for declaring God's care over them. When you speak these words, you are not merely voicing good wishes but invoking God's protection, grace, and peace. Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 54:17 "No weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you."
- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 "But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one."







Devotional: Claiming God's Powerful Protection

Protection is a vital aspect of your prayers. Psalm 91 reminds us that God actively sends His angels to guard and shield those He loves. When you pray, envision God's angelic protection surrounding your grandchildren—guiding their steps and defending them from harm.

We live in a world where dangers, both seen and unseen, exist. But God's promise is sure: He watches over His children with diligence and power. Isaiah 54:17 assures us that no weapon or scheme against them will succeed. This instills confidence as you pray boldly against any negative influences or threats.

Remember also to pray for spiritual protection (2 Thessalonians 3:3), that their faith will remain strong and unshaken despite challenges. Your prayers are a shield for their souls as much as their bodies.

List ways you can remind your grandchildren of God's protection as a part of your prayers and conversations with them.

Day 3: Wisdom and Guidance

Your Verse

Proverbs 3:5-6 - "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."
- Psalm 32:8 "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."







Day 3: Wisdom and Guidance

Devotional: Praying Wisdom and Clear Guidance

Grandchildren need God's wisdom to navigate life's complexities. Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us to help them trust God fully and to acknowledge Him in every decision. Prayer is key to helping them develop godly insight and discernment.

Your Verse

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 - "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud... it always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."

Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 8:38–39 "Nothing in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."
- Zephaniah 3:17 "The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing."







Devotional: Praying God's Unfailing Love Over Them

Love is the foundation of all you pray and declare. 1 Corinthians 13 gives us a beautiful description of Christlike love—patient, kind, enduring, and protective. When you pray this love over your grandchildren, you are asking God to surround them with His perfect love that never fails.

Your grandchildren need to deeply experience God's unconditional love to develop healthy identities and relationships. Romans 8:38–39 assures you that nothing can separate them from God's love, an unshakable truth to claim out loud.

Zephaniah 3:17 paints a vivid picture of God rejoicing over your grandchildren with singing—a tender reminder of how precious they are to Him. In your prayers, declare the reality of God's joyful and protective love, reinforcing their sense of worth and divine belonging.

Your Verse

Supporting Scriptures

- Galatians 5:22–23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control."
- 2 Peter 1:5-7 "...make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness;"







Day 5: Frowth and Character

Devotional: Praying for Spiritual Fruit and Growth

Spiritual and character growth define a life pleasing to God. Praying Colossians 1:10 over your grandchildren is about asking God to help them live thoroughly transformed lives—bearing good fruit and deepening their knowledge of Him.

The fruit of the Spirit listed in Galatians 5:22–23 represents qualities essential for godly character. When you pray for these attributes, you are requesting God's active work in shaping their hearts and personalities.

2 Peter 1:5-7 challenges believers to work diligently in growing faith and virtue. This shows that growth requires effort and God's enabling grace. Pray that your grandchildren will embrace this journey, developing a strong, godly character that impacts their families and communities.
