#### Devotional: Open Your Heart Fully to Christ Today

- Hebrews 10:23 "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess."







Day 3: ① Stand Firm in Faith and Hope

#### Devotional: Clothe Yourself in Faith, Love, and Hope

Spiritual readiness includes guarding your heart and mind with faith, love, and hope. These are your divine armor. Faith protects you from doubt, love shields your actions, and hope secures your mind toward the salvation that awaits.

Waiting can be challenging—discouragement and fears sometimes arise. But Scripture encourages believers to stand firm and stay sober-minded, clearly focused on the promises of God.

Remember that hope is not wishful thinking but confident expectation rooted in God's faithfulness. Cling to this hope and allow it to strengthen you daily.

#### Devotional: Daily Repentance Leads to Purity

A key step in spiritual preparation is ongoing repentance and heart purification. Before Jesus comes, it's vital that we confess honestly and receive His cleansing power. This transforms us internally, removing barriers between us and God.

Repentance is not a one-time event but a daily posture. It shows humility and dependence on Christ's grace to renew and restore your spirit. Psalm 51's heartfelt cry echoes this desire for purity.

Allow the Holy Spirit to reveal any hidden sin or attitudes needing correction. Embrace His forgiveness freely and walk forward in renewed holiness.
