Devotional: Guarding Your Heart in Secret Moments

- *Psalms 139:23-24 - "Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts."*



Devotional: Guarding Purity Through Mind and Secret Choices

Holiness in your private life begins with the purity of your thoughts.

Philippians 4:8 calls us to meditate on qualities that honor God. The mind is a powerful gateway influencing both secret desires and outward conduct. As women aiming for holiness, choosing what to think about shapes our daily walk.
