Day 1: **B** Embracing God's Design in Singleness

#### Your Verse

1 Corinthians 7:7 — 'I wish that all of you were as I am. But each of you has your own gift from God; one has this gift, another has that.'

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Matthew 19:12 'For there are eunuchs who have been so from birth...and there are those who choose to live like eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. The one who can accept this should accept it.'
- Psalm 34:18 'The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.'







Day 1: **B** Embracing God's Design in Singleness

#### Devotional: God's Gift of Singleness

Singleness is a gift from God, just as marriage is. In 1 Corinthians 7:7, Paul recognizes that not everyone is called to marriage; some are given the gift of singleness so they can serve God without distraction. This isn't a consolation prize—it is a distinct and honorable calling. If you find yourself single, it's important to embrace this season with grace and joy, knowing that it is part of God's perfect design for your life.

Sometimes singleness can feel lonely or isolating, but God's Word assures us that He is especially near to those who feel brokenhearted or crushed in spirit (Psalm 34:18). And like Jesus spoke in Matthew 19, some choose to stay single to devote themselves more fully to God's kingdom, showing that singleness can be a powerful form of service.

Today, consider how God's unique calling on your life as a single person can be a channel of blessing for you and for others. Are you embracing your singleness as a gift? How might God want to use your current season for greater kingdom impact?

#### Your Verse

1 Thessalonians 4:3-5 — 'It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honorable.'

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Philippians 4:13 'I can do all this through him who gives me strength.'
- Psalm 51:10 'Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.'







#### Devotional: Strengthened to Pursue Purity

Purity is not just about abstaining from sexual immorality; it is about living a life set apart for God's glory. In 1 Thessalonians 4:3–5, Paul instructs believers to pursue sanctification by exercising self–control over their bodies in a way that is holy and honorable. This includes guarding our thoughts, actions, and relationships with intentionality.

Living a pure life in singleness can be challenging in a culture that often promotes immediate gratification and blurred boundaries. But God offers us strength through the Holy Spirit. Philippians 4:13 reminds us that we can rely on Christ for the power to overcome temptation and maintain integrity.

Today, ask God to create in you a pure heart (Psalm 51:10) and to renew your spirit so that you can live with steadfastness. Remember, purity is a daily choice and an act of worship that honors God above all else.

#### Your Verse

- Psalm 37:4 'Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.'
- Proverbs 3:5-6 'Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.'







Day 3: 🛠 Finding Contentment in God Alone

#### Devotional: Learning Contentment in Every Season

#### Contentment is a precious fruit of the Spirit to cultivate in singleness.

Philippians 4:11-12 shows how Paul learned to be content regardless of his circumstances. This kind of contentment isn't based on external situations like relationships but is rooted deeply in trust and satisfaction in God alone.

When you find your highest joy and fulfillment in God, you're less likely to feel restless or incomplete because of singleness. Psalm 37:4 encourages us to delight in the Lord, promising that He will then give us the desires of our hearts—sometimes in ways we don't anticipate but are ultimately for our good.

Let today's focus be on trusting God fully, even when your heart longs for companionship. Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us that as we lean on Him and not our own understanding, He will direct our paths and provide true contentment and peace.

- James 1:5 'If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault.'







#### Devotional: Wisely Guarding Your Heart and Body

Guarding your heart and setting boundaries are vital to living a pure single life. Proverbs 4:23 reminds us that everything flows from the condition of the heart, so protecting it from harmful influences is essential. Boundaries include the relationships you cultivate, the media you consume, and the physical and emotional limits you set in dating and friendships.

Your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19–20), and honoring God involves respecting yourself and others through wise choices. These boundaries aren't restrictions—they are acts of love and worship that safeguard your well-being and spiritual health.

If you're unsure about where or how to set boundaries, James 1:5 offers wonderful encouragement to seek God's wisdom. When you ask Him in prayer, He promises to give generously to help you make wise decisions that honor Him and protect your heart.
