#### Devotional: Letting Your Life Speak Faith

#### Devotional: Create Safe Spaces for Faith Talk

Fostering bold faith requires that children feel heard and safe sharing their thoughts and questions. James reminds us to be quick listeners and patient speakers, creating a respectful dialogue grounded in grace. This approach helps children explore faith honestly without fear of judgment or anger.

Colossians encourages conversations full of kindness and wisdom, which can open doors for spiritual learning and boldness. Ephesians charges parents with training and instructing children in the Lord, which is best done through ongoing, gentle conversations that address life and faith experiences.

Consider how often you listen actively and respond graciously when your child expresses doubts, curiosities, or desires about faith. These open talks plant seeds of confidence to share faith themselves.
