Devotional: Teaching Sons to Love Through Your Example

Sons often learn how to love by observing the women who raise them. 1 Corinthians 13 beautifully describes the qualities of love: patience, kindness, and humility — virtues essential for godly leadership. When mothers and mentors embody these traits, they create a living lesson.

In a culture that frequently confuses love with selfishness or weakness, demonstrating true biblical love grounds sons in a stronger understanding. John 13:34 reminds us that love is a command, modeled supremely by Jesus Himself. Teaching sons to love well involves daily actions: listening, forgiving, serving others with kindness.

By clothing your heart in compassion, as Colossians 3 encourages, you teach young men to be tender and gracious leaders—qualities the world urgently needs. Let your love be the example your sons will carry forward.
