Josiah's revival changed a nation; revival still shapes the world today. When hearts are revived individually and collectively, the result is impact—transformed communities, justice, and hope. Your personal revival can ripple outward.

Pray and plan how God might use your life's renewal to influence your corner of the world. Revival is never an isolated experience but an invitation to be salt and light, rebuilding foundations fractured by sin.






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
