Day 2: Experiencing God's Rescue



Your Verse

Psalms 107:28-30 – Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress.

Supporting Scriptures

- *Jonah 2:2 – In my distress I called to the Lord, and he answered me.*
- *2 Corinthians 1:10 – He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us.*



Devotional: Calling Out to God Brings Restoration

Psalm 107 vividly portrays people caught in the storms of life—literal or figurative—crying out to God in desperation. **Verses 28–30** remind us that God hears our cries and acts to rescue us from distress. This is the heart of redemption: when we acknowledge our helplessness and call on the Lord, He responds with power and compassion.

It is so important to recognize that God does not wait for us to be perfect or self-sufficient before intervening. Instead, He invites us to bring our whole selves, wounds and weaknesses included, into His loving presence. When we cry out, we lay aside pride and embrace dependence on God as our Savior.

Reflect on your personal 'storms'—times when you felt overwhelmed, alone, or trapped. How did God show up? Maybe it was through a breakthrough, peace in the midst of chaos, or provision when you felt helpless. God's redemption is active and personal; He yearns to deliver us and restore our souls.

Today, let's commit to calling out to God faithfully, trusting in His rescue even when the waves rise high.



Reflect and Apply

1. What struggles or 'storms' have made you cry out to God recently?

2. How does it feel to know God is attentive to your distress and ready to rescue you?

3. Are there areas where you struggle to rely on God fully during difficult times?



Journaling Prompts

1. Describe a time when God delivered you from a difficult situation.

2. Write a prayer expressing your trust in God's rescue today.

3. Reflect on barriers that keep you from fully depending on God and pray about them.

- *Psalm 30:11 – You turned my wailing into dancing; you removed my sackcloth and clothed me with joy.*
