Day 1: P Recognizing Emotional Distance

Devotional: Heart Awareness: Identifying Signs of Distance

Emotional distance often starts with small cracks in communication and connection. It reflects a guarded heart and a slowing of relational intimacy. Proverbs 4:23 reminds us to guard our hearts—because the condition of our heart influences all aspects of our marriage.
