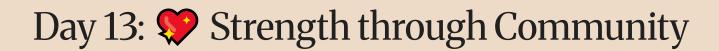

Patience can be difficult in the face of illness. However, God's timing is perfect and purposeful. Ecclesiastes reminds us that every season has its time, including the waiting seasons that test our faith.

During treatment or recovery, waiting may feel like the hardest part. Yet Psalm 27 encourages strength and courage while waiting on the Lord. This waiting isn't passive but an active trusting of God's plan.

As you await healing or answers, lean on God to renew your strength, cultivating patience as you rest in His timing and sovereignty.
