#### **Prayer for Today**

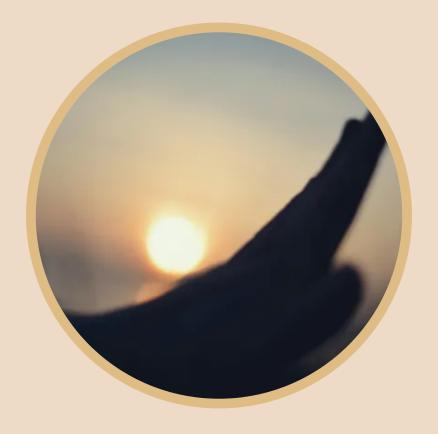

Day 2: 🗱 Focusing on What is Good

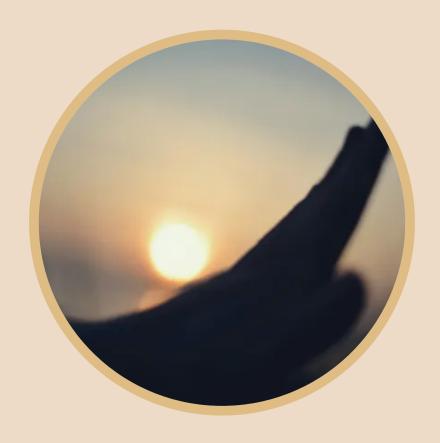
#### Prayer for Today

#### Devotional: Replacing Anxiety with God's Peace

#### Your Verse

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 42:11 "Why, my soul, are you downcast? Put your hope in God."







#### Devotional: God Fills You with Hope and Joy

	Reflect on how trusting God changes your emotional response to hardship.







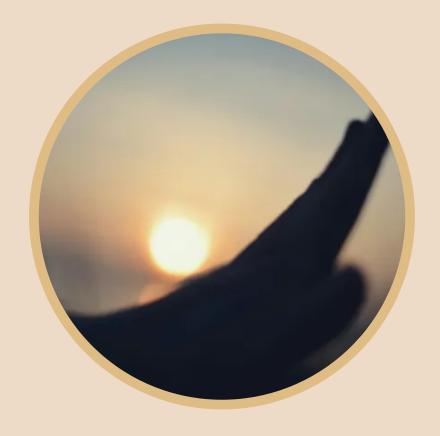
#### Prayer for Today

#### Prayer for Today

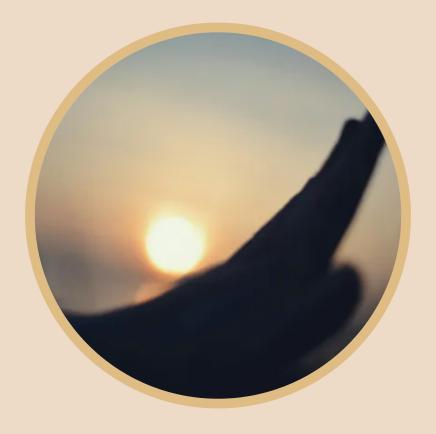
