Our **God of compassion** sees you, values you, and holds your story close — not as something to define you but as a testimony of His grace and power. Through this study, you'll discover how Scripture reclaims your identity as beloved, cherished, and uniquely created by God. You will be invited to embrace freedom from shame and walking in the confidence of God's promises.

Throughout these 21 days, you will read powerful passages that reveal God's character, healing power, and purpose for your life. You will find encouragement, comfort, and practical applications for your heart and soul. *This study is a sacred space where your pain is acknowledged and met with God's redeeming love.* Whether your experience was recent or long ago, the trauma you carry is not a barrier to God's grace or a limitation on your future.

Each day includes a primary Scripture with supporting verses to deepen your understanding, a devotional to guide your reflection, targeted journaling







prompts to engage your heart, and a prayer to lift your spirit. Take your time with each day—allow God's truth to saturate your mind and soul.

Remember: Healing is a process that requires patience, trust, and the courage to lean into God's faithfulness. You are not alone. God's Word promises to set the captives free — this includes freedom from shame and fear. May you discover renewed identity, strength, and hope in Him on this sacred journey.

Day 1:

Devotional: Resting in God's Unbreakable Love

When we feel broken or unworthy, one of the most powerful truths to hold onto is that God's love remains steadfast. Sexual abuse and the trauma it causes create deep wounds and may attempt to convince us that we are unloved, shameful, or alone. But Scripture reassures us that nothing—not our past, pain, or mistakes—can separate us from God's love.

Today's verses invite you to rest in the security of God's embrace. You are deeply loved by the Creator of the universe—who knows your suffering intimately and draws close to your broken heart.

As you begin this journey, ask God to reveal His love in new and real ways, replacing shame with the truth that you are cherished beyond measure. The enemy whispers lies, but God's Word declares freedom and acceptance just as you are.

Day 2: W Freedom from Shame

Devotional: Confession Brings Healing and Freedom

Shame is a powerful and corrosive force, but God's truth brings freedom. Today's Scripture reminds us that when we bring our brokenness and mistakes to God in honesty, He offers complete forgiveness and purification.

Survivors of sexual abuse may feel trapped in shame, even when it is not their fault. But the Bible makes clear that God's forgiveness is not only about sin but also about releasing the heavy burden of shame and self-condemnation.

Confession is more than acknowledgment of sin—it is opening our hearts to God's grace. In this act, God's faithfulness shines brightest by wiping away all unrighteousness and setting us free to walk with renewed dignity.

Today, consider what shame may be you need to surrender to God. Trust His justice and mercy to heal and restore your heart.

Sexual abuse can leave us feeling broken and worthless. But Scripture declares you are fearfully and wonderfully made—valued beyond measure by your Creator. Your story, including the painful chapters, has been woven into God's greater plan to redeem and restore.

Today, meditate on your true identity as God's masterpiece. Let go of the lies that diminish your worth and embrace the new life and purpose God offers. Rest in the truth that you have been recreated, whole and loved.

Your worth is not determined by human opinion or the wounds you have suffered. God's intimate knowledge of you—down to the very hairs on your head—speaks volumes about your value in His eyes.

Let today be a day to receive God's special affection. Allow His joy to fill your heart and silence the voices of shame. You are deeply valued, cherished, and treasured by God Himself.
