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#### Your Verse

Genesis 2:2–3 NIV – "By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work."

- Exodus 20:8-10 "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God."

#### Devotional: God's Example Shows Rest Is Essential

God Himself rested after creating the world. This is the foundation for understanding rest not as laziness but as divine rhythm. - Luke 5:16 "But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed."
- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."







#### Devotional: Following Jesus' Lead to Rest

**Even in His busy ministry, Jesus prioritized rest.** This shows us that rest is not optional even for those with the greatest purpose. Jesus invites us to follow His lead—stepping away from busyness to restore our soul.

Resting is a spiritual act of receiving from God, not merely pausing work. #### Devotional: Grace Frees You from Rest Guilt

Guilt about rest often comes from a performance mindset. We feel we must earn our worth through constant work. But the gospel reminds us that our value is a gift, not based on productivity.

God calls us to work wholeheartedly, but He also frees us from condemnation when we need rest. Faith in Christ assures us that resting does not diminish our identity or calling.
