Day 1: **B** Embracing Your Season with Peace

Devotional: Finding Peace in God's Timing

Often, singleness comes with feelings of restlessness or anxiety about when your circumstances will change. **God invites you to pause** and find peace amid uncertainty. Psalm 46:10 calls us to be still—not to act out of pressure or fear, but to rest in the sovereign presence of God.

Embracing your season means trusting that God's timing is perfect, even if it differs from your own plans. Isaiah reminds us that those who place their hope in God will receive renewed strength. This renewal is a deep, internal peace that lasts beyond fleeting happiness.

Jesus' invitation to the weary is for all, including those walking alone. Through resting in His promises, you can release anxieties and lean into the assurance that your path is known by Him. This day is about surrendering your fears and stepping into the rest God lovingly offers in this single season.

Devotional: Your Worth Is Rooted in God

Many singles can struggle with identity, especially when society often ties worth to relationship status. Yet, Scripture reveals that **your true identity comes from God alone**. Galatians 2:20 reminds us that living by faith in Jesus shapes our whole being more than external labels or circumstances.

You are wonderfully made by God's hands, intentionally created with a purpose and intricate design (Psalm 139:14). Your value isn't determined by your singleness or coupled status but by who God says you are.

Jeremiah assures that God has plans filled with hope for your life. This includes this very season. Embracing your identity in Him allows you to walk confidently, not out of comparison or pressure but from the knowledge that God's love is constant and defining.

Devotional: Joy is Possible and Powerful Now

Singleness can sometimes feel isolating, but God's word encourages us to rejoice regardless of circumstances. **Joy is an intentional choice rooted in the Lord, not dependent on external factors.**

Philippians 4:4 exhorts believers to rejoice always. This deep, abiding joy empowers us to face challenges with strength. Nehemiah reminds that the joy of the Lord is our true strength — a source of hope that uplifts the weary.

Jesus desires our joy to be complete, full and enduring (John 15:11). Cultivating joy in singleness means focusing on God's unfailing promises, cherishing His presence, and embracing the blessings that this season brings.

Devotional: Living Fully Where You Are

Instead of seeing singleness as just a waiting room, Scripture calls believers to live fully and purposefully in the present moment. **God assigns each season** with intention, and we can choose to serve and grow now.

Paul's words in 1 Corinthians challenge us to embrace whatever situation God places us in, trusting that it is part of His plan. Colossians encourages wholehearted devotion in every effort, reminding us that our work and service are for the Lord.

You are God's masterpiece, designed to do good works now—even during your single season (Ephesians 2:10). Discovering purpose and serving others can bring fulfillment and deepen your reliance on God's strength and guidance.

Devotional: Surrendering to God's Faithful Guidance

Trusting God wholeheartedly is key to resting in singleness. Proverbs wisely instructs us to lean not on our own understanding but to trust God with all our heart. When we do, He promises to direct our paths clearly and faithfully.

Even when life's future feels uncertain, Romans 8:28 assures us that God works all things—good and bad—for the benefit of those who love Him. This encouragement means your single season is part of a bigger, divine story where God's goodness prevails.

Jeremiah calls those who trust in the Lord blessed. Blessing here includes peace, contentment, and assurance. Surrendering your plans and timing to God frees you to rest in His perfect will, confident that He is leading you exactly where you need to be.
