#### Devotional: Discovering Your New Self in Christ

Today, we begin by embracing the powerful truth that your identity is renewed in Christ. Narcissistic control often distorts how we view ourselves, causing confusion between who we are and the image others try to impose. But Scripture reassures us that in Christ, you are a new creation. Your past chains do not define your present or your future.

Paul reminds us in 2 Corinthians 5:17 that everything old has passed away and everything has become new. This is not a superficial statement but a deep spiritual transformation. When you choose to anchor your identity in Christ, you start stepping out of victimhood and into victory.

Reflect on what it means for your old self to have gone away and for the new self to emerge. God crafted you uniquely for His purpose. Today, choose to receive the freedom to be the woman God created you to be—set free from manipulation, valued beyond measure, and empowered to live boldly.

Remember that this journey is not about relying on your own strength, which can falter. Instead, it's about surrendering to God's power that cannot be shaken. The Psalmist calls God an ever-present help, a refuge where we can run to be renewed and safe.

Lean into God's strength today. Let Him strengthen your spirit as you face the lingering effects of manipulation, and trust that He is equipping you to move toward healing and restoration at your own pace.

Forgiveness doesn't mean excusing the harmful behavior or forgetting what happened; it means choosing to no longer allow the wrongs done to control your life and emotions.

*Reflect on how forgiveness can unshackle you.* When you forgive, you reclaim your heart and restore peace within, inviting God's healing to take root deeply inside your soul.

But Scripture tells us differently: you belong to a royal priesthood, chosen and precious in God's sight. The Holy Spirit affirms your identity as His child every day.

Today, receive the truth about your worth. Remember you don't have to prove yourself or earn God's love; it is given freely because of who He is. Let this truth restore your confidence and help you reject the lies of control that have questioned your value.

Remember, Romans tells us there is no condemnation in Christ. Your mistakes or the sins of those who hurt you do not define your future. As David experienced in Psalm 34, God hears your cries and can deliver you from all your fears.

Let today be a turning point. Acknowledge the fear and shame but refuse to let them rule you. Stand confidently in God's promise to carry your burdens and set you free.

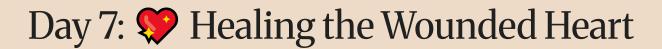
