Let this study be your sanctuary. May it nurture your soul as you learn to lean fully into the Shepherd's arms, where you are valued, cherished, and shielded. Together, let us take these steps of faith, trust, and restoration.

Devotional: Finding Refuge Under God's Wings

Imagine resting under God's wings: you are shielded from harm, guarded by unfailing faithfulness. You are safe, secure, and valued, not because of your strength, but because of who God is.

When dark memories and fears assault your mind, remember that God is your refuge—a fortress where nothing can truly harm your spirit. The wounds you carry are surrounded by His promises to protect and uphold you.

Today, let your soul settle into His wings. Feel the assurance of shelter and protection even when circumstances feel uncertain or frightening.
