Day 1: 🌿 Trusting God's Wisdom Over Your Own



Your Verse

Proverbs 3:5-6 - "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

Supporting Scriptures

- *James 1:5 - "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."*
- *Psalms 32:8 - "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."*



Devotional: Learning to Trust God Completely

When faced with career decisions, it's tempting to rely on our own knowledge, experience, or what seems practical to us. Yet, the Bible encourages us to completely trust God rather than our limited understanding. Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us that when we acknowledge God and submit our ways to Him, He will direct our steps.

This is invitation to surrender control and invite God into your vocational choices. If you are uncertain about which direction to take, God promises to give wisdom when you ask in faith. James 1:5 promises that God gives wisdom generously — no question too small or situation too complicated.

As you consider your career, pause and ask God to reveal His plan. Trust may feel difficult when the future looks unclear, but His loving guidance is sure. Psalm 32:8 reveals how God watches over us with care and offers instruction and counsel.

Let this truth sink deeply: God's wisdom is personal and attentive toward you. His plans for your career will lead to a good and straight path.

1. In what areas of your career are you tempted to rely solely on your own understanding?

2. How do you currently seek God's guidance about your vocational path?

3. What would it look like in practice to "submit all your ways" to God today?

2. List ways you can intentionally invite God's counsel into your vocational choices.

3. Reflect on a time when trusting God led to a positive outcome in your work life.

Your Verse

Jeremiah 29:11 – "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Colossians 3:23 – "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters."*
- *Romans 12:2 – "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind... to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."*



Day 2: 🏡 Aligning Career Choices with God's Purpose

Devotional: Working Wholeheartedly for God's Glory

Your career is not just about earning a living but fulfilling God's greater purpose for your life. Jeremiah 29:11 assures us that God has specific plans for each of us—plans to prosper and give hope, not harm or disappointment.

Sometimes, career choices can feel disconnected from spiritual significance. However, Scripture calls us to see work as an act of worship. Colossians 3:23 reminds us to work wholeheartedly as if serving the Lord directly, not just human employers.

To align your career with God's purpose means renewing your mind and discerning His will. Romans 12:2 challenges us not to conform to worldly values but to open our hearts to transformation through God's truth.

This day invites you to reflect on whether your vocational path reflects God's good, pleasing, and perfect will. When you pursue career steps with a heart submitted to God, your work becomes a meaningful expression of His calling on your life.



Reflect and Apply

1. How does knowing God has a purpose for your career encourage you?

2. In what ways can your current or future job serve God's plans?

3. Are there worldly expectations you feel pressured to follow that conflict with God's will?

1. Write about how your career goals align or differ from what you sense God's purpose to be.

2. List practical steps to renew your mind to God's will for your vocational journey.

3. Describe how working 'as for the Lord' might change your attitude or approach to work.

Your Verse

John 16:13 – "But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Isaiah 30:21 – "Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it.'"*
- *Psalms 25:4-5 – "Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths; guide me in your truth and teach me..."*



Day 3:  Inviting the Holy Spirit to Guide Your Decisions

Devotional: Walking Hand in Hand with the Spirit

God doesn't expect us to figure out vocational decisions on our own. He gives us the Holy Spirit, the Counselor, to guide us into truth and clarity. John 16:13 assures us that the Spirit will lead us in ways we need to go.

When you feel uncertain or overwhelmed about your career, remember that God's Spirit will speak to your heart. Isaiah 30:21 paints a beautiful picture of hearing a clear, loving voice directing you to the right path—whether it's turning right or left.

Inviting the Holy Spirit daily means opening your heart to His promptings and trusting His gentle guidance. Psalm 25:4–5 expresses a heartfelt prayer to be shown God's ways and taught His paths.

Today is a call not just to seek wisdom intellectually but to cultivate a relationship where the Spirit actively guides you through prayer, Scripture, and quiet listening. Your career isn't just a set of choices—it's a journey walked hand in hand with the Spirit of God.



Reflect and Apply

1. How do you experience God's Spirit guiding your life currently?

2. What are practical ways you can tune your heart to hear the Spirit's voice about career decisions?

3. Are there any doubts or fears holding you back from fully trusting the Spirit's guidance?



Journaling Prompts

1. Write a prayer inviting the Holy Spirit to guide your vocational choices.

2. Describe moments when you sensed God's direction in your work life.

3. Reflect on how you can create space daily to listen for God's guidance.
