Devotional: Work Wholeheartedly as Worship to God

Devotional: Faithful Integrity Guards Your Path

Integrity is the foundation of a career that honors God. Proverbs 10:9 highlights the security that comes with living and working honestly. When we commit to integrity, we guard our hearts and reputations even when shortcuts seem tempting.

Working without recognition can sometimes tempt us to compromise values or cut corners. But Scripture encourages faithfulness, even in small things (Luke 16:10). God blesses and entrusts us with more when we prove trustworthy.

Devotional: Endure Daily with God's Strength and Promise

Working diligently without recognition can sometimes lead to weariness. Galatians 6:9 encourages us not to give up but to keep persevering because a harvest will come in God's timing.

Devotional: Set Your Heart on Lasting Treasure
