Devotional: Letting God's Wisdom Flow Through You

Wisdom is a hallmark of godly grandmothers who serve their church well.

Proverbs 31 praises the woman who uses her words wisely to teach and encourage others. Such wisdom is not merely intellectual knowledge but godly insight — practical, compassionate, and spiritually rooted.

James 3 describes heavenly wisdom as pure and peace-loving, full of mercy and good fruit. As a grandmother, your words can uplift, calm conflicts, and foster unity. This wisdom nurtures spiritual growth and maturity in the church.

Devotional: Passing Faith Through Generations
