#### Devotional: God Raises Courage in Hard Times

#### Devotional: Using God-Given Tools for Victory

Shamgar's victory was achieved with an unlikely weapon — an oxgoad, a farming tool rather than a sword. This speaks volumes about how God uses what we have, however ordinary it seems, to bring about His plans. It's not about the strength of the weapon but the power of God behind it.

Faith and obedience become our true weapons in spiritual battles. When God calls us to act, even if we feel unprepared, we can trust that He makes our efforts effective. Shamgar's story challenges us to reflect on what tools and talents God has placed in our hands that we might underestimate.

What 'oxgoad' might God be asking you to pick up? Are you willing to use what you have, rely on Him, and engage in His work boldly and faithfully?

#### Devotional: God Uses the Weak and Unexpected

Shamgar stands as an example of God choosing people unexpected by the world's standards to fulfill His mighty purposes. The Bible repeatedly reveals that God's power often shines brightest through those considered weak or insignificant by society.

This truth brings great encouragement. It means that no matter our background, status, or abilities, God can and will use us if we are willing. Shamgar's victory reminds us that our calling and effectiveness come from God's choosing, not from human qualifications.

Reflect on how you view your own place in God's plan. Are you willing to trust Him to use you, perhaps in ways you don't yet understand? Let Shamgar inspire courage to step into God's call, even when it feels beyond your capability.

#### Devotional: Faith Moves Forward Courageously

Shamgar's story fits within the larger narrative of biblical heroes who conquered challenges through faith-activated action. Faith is not passive; it calls us to act boldly in trust that God will work through our steps.

The heroes mentioned in Hebrews 11 are examples of living faith—faith that moves mountains and defeats enemies. Shamgar's victory echoes this truth. It reminds us that God calls us to trust Him wholeheartedly and then take the action He requires, even when it's risky or uncertain.

- Revelation 12:11 "They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death."
