#### Devotional: Begin with Trust in God's Sovereignty

**Trusting God's sovereignty** is the essential starting point when we consider sharing End Times dreams. #### Devotional: Embrace Humility When Sharing

Sharing End Times dreams requires a heart posture of **humility**. The Apostle Paul reminds us in Philippians to do nothing out of selfish ambition or pride. It's easy to assume that because we received a dream, our interpretation must be correct or that we are called to be prophetic voices. However, God calls us to consider others above ourselves and seek their spiritual well-being.

Humility involves acknowledging our limitations and the possibility of error. James and Peter strongly warn that God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. When we share dreams with humility, we open space for dialogue, correction, and peace rather than division or fear.

Before sharing your dream, ask God to soften your heart and remove any desire to impress or control. Approach conversations as a servant who desires to edify others, not as one who must be heard. Humility is a magnet for God's grace and guidance in all things, especially in sensitive topics like End Times revelations.

Day 3: Grounding in God's Word

The Apostle Paul reminds Timothy that all Scripture is inspired by God and essential for teaching and correction. Dreams must never contradict the clear teachings of the Bible.

Your dreams can serve as personal reflections or encouragements, but the Bible holds ultimate authority. Psalm 119 declares God's Word to be a lamp and light, illuminating our path through confusion and uncertainty. As you interpret and share your dreams, constantly measure them against biblical truth.

Hebrews 4:12 tells us the Word is alive and able to discern the thoughts and intentions of the heart. When Scripture shapes your sharing, your words will carry authority from God—not merely from personal experience. This keeps discussions balanced, truthful, and centered on God's promises and warnings.

#### Devotional: Practice Discernment and Test All Things

To share your End Times dreams responsibly, **testing and discernment** are crucial. Paul instructs the Thessalonians to not reject prophetic words outright but to test everything carefully. This wisdom helps prevent deception or spreading false ideas.

John's epistle adds that testing involves spiritual discernment—asking whether what we receive aligns with God's Spirit. Similarly, the Bereans studied Scripture daily to verify Paul's teachings. We are called to cultivate this diligence in examining both our dreams and the words we share about them.

Discernment requires humility and prayer, asking God for wisdom to distinguish truth from error. When sharing your dreams, explain that your interpretations are subject to testing and correction. This invites community dialogue and safeguards against elevating personal messages above God's Word.

### Devotional: Communicate with Grace and Compassion

Your dreams may bring urgent or sobering messages, but presenting them gently invites open ears and hearts rather than defensiveness. Colossians advises us to let our speech be gracious and wise, reflecting the love of Christ.

Proverbs teaches that gentle words can defuse conflict, while harshness inflames it. Approach conversations prayerfully, choosing words that reflect God's compassion rather than alarmism. Love strengthens your witness and honors God more than dramatic declarations ever could.

Understanding that dreams serve purposes such as encouragement, guidance, or caution helps frame how we share them. This awareness promotes respect for God's timing and wisdom rather than rushing to sensationalize every detail.

In a world filled with sensational stories, it can be tempting to dramatize End Times dreams to gain attention or stir emotions. However, Paul urges Timothy to avoid myths and focus on godliness. Sensationalism distracts from the true gospel message and can cause confusion or fear.

Proverbs explains that the simple believe everything, while the prudent consider carefully before acting. By choosing sobriety and sound judgment, you honor God and protect others from harm.

Ecclesiastes reminds us to value wise correction over flattery or excitement. When sharing dreams, resist exaggeration and focus on delivering God's truth in a straightforward, humble manner. This approach builds trust and a solid foundation for meaningful spiritual conversations.

Galatians describes love as part of the fruit of the Spirit, evidence that the Holy Spirit is working within us. When love fuels your dreams' sharing, it manifests as kindness, patience, and gentleness, all vital for fruitful ministry.

Reflect often on whether your sharing encourages and uplifts others. Love means seeking the good of others above your own need to be heard. When you love well, your words become a channel of God's grace, inspiring hope and faith.

Philippians encourages bringing all anxieties and requests to God with thanksgiving. Prayer brings peace and clarity, preventing fear-driven sharing or impulsive interpretations. Make prayer your ongoing habit as you navigate this sensitive topic.

Practicing patience means resisting pressure to rush your sharing or push others before they are ready. It also involves trusting God to reveal and clarify dreams gradually. Patience fosters peace and respect in relationships.
