Your Verse

Revelation 12:11 - "They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Psalm 66:16 - "Come and hear, all you who fear God; let me tell you what he has done for me."*
- *John 9:25 - "One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!"*



Devotional: Victory Through Your Testimony

Prayer for Today

Your Verse

Romans 8:28 - "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Jeremiah 29:11 - "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."*
- *Isaiah 40:31 - "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength."*



Devotional: God's Purpose in Every Veteran's Path

Your veteran journey is unique, but it's not without purpose. Romans 8:28 reassures us that God weaves all experiences—good and difficult—into a greater plan to bless and strengthen those who trust Him. Every deployment, every challenge, and every triumph has significance beyond the moment.

Sometimes veterans may wrestle with the weight of what they've seen or done. But God says He has good plans for you, plans full of hope as Jeremiah 29:11 promises. When you embrace your story, flaws and all, it becomes an authentic testimony of God's restorative work in your life.

Day 3: 📢 Boldness to Speak Truth



Your Verse

2 Timothy 1:7 – "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Acts 1:8 – "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses."*
- *Proverbs 28:1 – "The wicked flee though no one pursues, but the righteous are as bold as a lion."*



Devotional: Courage to Share Your Story

Sharing your testimony requires boldness, but God equips you. 2 Timothy 1:7 reminds us that the Spirit within gives power, love, and self-discipline—not fear. Veterans often exhibit courage in service; now, that courage extends to speaking truth about what God has done.

The early church received power through the Holy Spirit to be bold witnesses, as Acts 1:8 shows. You have the same Spirit available to empower your words and actions today. When you speak from the heart, you reflect not only your experience but also God's transforming love.

Remember Proverbs 28:1's encouragement: boldness declares righteousness and faith. Let God's Spirit calm any fears and inspire you to tell your story with confidence, that others may be drawn closer to Christ through your testimony.

Day 4: Authenticity in Sharing



Your Verse

Ephesians 4:25 - "Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Psalm 51:6 - "Surely you desire truth in the inner parts; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place."*
- *Matthew 5:8 - "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God."*



Devotional: Sharing Your Story with Honest Heart

Authenticity honors God and builds trust. Ephesians 4:25 commands believers to speak truthfully, embracing honesty in community. Your testimony should be a genuine reflection of your heart, including struggles, doubts, and victories. Authentic sharing resonates powerfully because it reflects real life.

Psalm 51 highlights God's desire for inner truth. When you allow God to purify your heart and reveal wisdom, your testimony becomes more than words—it becomes a living witness to God's grace. As Matthew 5:8 says, purity of heart brings closeness with God and clarity to your message.

Be transparent. It's okay to admit imperfections. Vulnerability connects and encourages others who may relate to your challenges. God can transform every part of your veteran journey into a testimony that uplifts and glorifies Him.

Prayer for Today

- *Psalms 143:10 - "Teach me to do your will, for you are my God."*

Devotional: Letting the Spirit Lead Your Testimony

Your speech and heart are directed by the Holy Spirit. Jesus promised the Spirit of truth will guide believers into all truth. When preparing and sharing your testimony, ask the Holy Spirit to lead you to say what honors God and touches hearts.

The fruit of the Spirit in Galatians 5 shows qualities your story should reflect—love, peace, and gentleness, not just facts or feelings. These fruits make your testimony impactful and welcoming. The Spirit not only guides words but also cultivates the heart attitude needed for effective testimony.

Psalm 143:10 expresses a desire to follow God's will. As a veteran, your testimony can align perfectly with God's purpose when you invite His guidance daily. Trust that the Holy Spirit will teach and empower you to share your story in ways that glorify God and help others.

Your Verse

Supporting Scriptures

- *Psalms 27:14 - "Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord."*



Day 6: 🙏 Trusting God's Timing

Devotional: Patience in Sharing Your Story

Sharing your testimony is powerful, but trust God's timing. Ecclesiastes reminds us that there is a right season for every purpose. Sometimes you may feel ready to share, other times God may be preparing your heart or the listener's.

Habakkuk speaks of waiting for revelation at the appointed time. God orchestrates when your testimony will have the greatest impact—be patient and obedient. Psalm 27 encourages strength and courage during waiting periods.

Trust that God is using your veteran story exactly when and where it is needed. Your readiness, combined with His perfect timing, maximizes the blessing for you and those who hear.

Supporting Scriptures

- *Hebrews 10:24 - "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds."*
- *Philippians 2:15-16 - "...so that you may become blameless and pure, 'children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation.' Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky..."*



Devotional: Be a Light Through Your Testimony

Your testimony is a gift to inspire and uplift others. 1 Peter 3:15 calls believers to readiness—to share the hope within with gentleness and respect. Your veteran story carries the hope of God’s redemption, courage, and peace. It can challenge, encourage, and guide those who may feel lost or broken.

Hebrews urges us to motivate one another to love and good deeds. By sharing openly, you become a catalyst for change and healing in your community. Philippians paints a beautiful picture of believers shining like stars—your testimony is part of that light.

Let your story point to Jesus as the source of your hope and strength. Your courage, faith, and witness can ignite faith in others and glorify God profoundly.
