Devotional: Finding Purpose in Your Single Season

Singleness is not just a waiting room for marriage, but a purposeful season to focus on God. Paul reminds us that an unmarried person can give full attention to the Lord's affairs. This is a powerful invitation to embrace singleness with joy and intention rather than frustration or impatience.

Fasting in this stage can sharpen your focus and deepen your sensitivity to God's voice. When the usual distractions fall away, you create space to grow spiritually and consider how God is shaping your future, whether in relationships, ministry, or personal growth. Remember, God's plans are good and full of hope.

Take time to rest in the truth that delighting in God shifts your desires to align with His perfect will.

Devotional: Wisdom and Clarity in Seeking God's Direction

Seeking God's will requires wisdom, guidance, and attentive listening. James encourages believers to ask God for wisdom confidently. When fasting, this prayerful posture removes distractions and sharpens our spiritual hearing.

God desires to lead you step-by-step if you seek Him earnestly. Singleness is an ideal season to cultivate habits of listening—through Scripture, prayer, fasting, and quiet reflection—that reveal His clear direction.

Ask God today to teach you His paths and to help you recognize His voice amid life's noise. Remember that He promises guidance when you turn to Him fully.
