### Devotional: Let Love Guide Your Words and Actions

### Devotional: Embracing Forgiveness to Heal Relationships

Forgiveness is essential to restore and maintain healthy relationships.

Forgiveness requires humility, kindness, and compassion—the same qualities Paul encourages in Ephesians. It may be difficult, but the freedom and healing that come from forgiveness are profound.

To speak Scripture in this context means gently reminding others of God's mercy and calling for reconciliation. It also means prayerfully seeking God's help to forgive and rebuild trust. Today, reflect on any relationships burdened by unforgiveness and ask God to help you be a channel of His healing grace.
