Proverbs teaches trust in God over personal insight, inviting you to surrender your creative choices and environment decisions to Him. When facing confusing or tempting situations, pause and seek God's wisdom before proceeding.

James encourages submission to God as the first defense against the enemy. Setting Godly boundaries is about saying yes to God and no to what dims His light in your artistry. This might mean saying no to certain collaborations, content, or environments that challenge your obedience.
