Your Verse

Psalm 18:2 – "The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."
- 2 Samuel 22:3 "My God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation."







Day 1: **(**) God Is My Fortress

Devotional: Finding Refuge in God's Unshakable Fortress

In the heat of battle, knowing where to find refuge is crucial. David begins his spiritual warfare journey by affirming the Lord as his fortress—a stronghold that cannot be breached. - Ephesians 6:17 "Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."







Day 2: XX The Lord Is My Weapon

Devotional: Equipped and Trained by God for Battle

David's declaration that the Lord trains his hands for war highlights an essential truth: God equips His people for spiritual battle. Warfare against unseen enemies calls for strength and skill that only the Lord can provide.

Our spiritual weaponry isn't physical but rooted in faith, prayer, and God's Word. Paul reminds us that divine weapons demolish strongholds—false beliefs, temptations, and fears that try to control us.

Day 3: 🖰 The Lord's Fire and Power

Devotional: God's Consuming Fire Burns Away Darkness

God's power is fierce and purifying — described as consuming fire in Psalm 97. This fire consumes His enemies and purifies His people. In spiritual warfare, God's fiery presence defeats darkness and destroys the works of the enemy.

Devotional: The Power of Crying Out to God
