### Devotional: Growing in God-Given Discernment

Discernment is essential in protecting your congregation and your own heart. John commands believers to test the spirits—to investigate carefully whether a teaching truly comes from God. This active vigilance prevents deception from taking root.

The Bereans set an example for us by studying Scripture daily and verifying teachings against God's Word. They did not accept anything at face value but examined everything rigorously. In our day, this same vigilance is needed to combat clever falsehoods.

Ask the Lord to sharpen your spiritual senses so you can distinguish truth from error. Discernment grows through prayer, Scripture study, and humility to learn. Without it, even well-meaning men can lead others astray.

# Devotional: Embracing Boldness to Defend the Gospel

It takes courage to stand against false teaching, especially when it may cause conflict or rejection. Paul instructs Titus that leaders must firmly hold to sound doctrine and have the boldness to refute those who contradict the gospel.

God's Spirit empowers us not to be timid but to respond with love and strength. Boldness is not belligerence; it is a confident and loving commitment to defend truth. Pastoral men are called to uphold the Word, even when it's uncomfortable.

Pray today for boldness to speak out. Remember that your courage can protect many from deception and error. Your voice matters in preserving the faithfulness of your community.

#### Devotional: Balancing Boldness and Compassion



Vigilance, humility, and constant dependence on the Holy Spirit are required. This includes not only public leaders but any man who influences others spiritually.

Ask God for eyes to see spiritual danger and a heart willing to act decisively in love for the church's purity and health.

## Devotional: Defending the Gospel with Clarity and Conviction

**False teachings often distort or undermine the true gospel.** Paul expresses astonishment at believers deserting the gospel of grace for false messages disguised as truth.

Clarifying and defending the gospel is foundational to protecting a congregation. You must know what the gospel is and be able to articulate it clearly.

Use today to reflect on the gospel's core truths and how you communicate them. Commit to contending earnestly for the faith handed down to us.

# Day 13: Compassion: Caring for Those Deceived









#### Your Verse

Jude 1:22 - 'Be merciful to those who doubt;'

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Galatians 6:1 'Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently.'
- 2 Corinthians 2:7 'Instead, you ought to forgive and comfort him, so that he will not be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow.'







## Devotional: Balancing Truth with Compassion for the Lost

Many fall prey to false teaching out of genuine confusion or deception. Jude exhorts believers to show mercy to those who doubt and to gently restore others caught in error.

Compassion does not contradict truth but enhances its power. Harshness alienates, but tender care invites healing and repentance.

Pray for a heart of compassion towards those deceived, seeking their restoration rather than judgment.

- Philippians 3:17 'Join together in following my example, brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do.'







#### Devotional: Following Godly Examples for Wisdom

Wisdom is built not only on personal experience but learning from godly leaders who preceded us. Hebrews and Paul urge believers to remember and imitate their leaders' faithful example.

As a man standing firm against false teaching, look to mentors and biblical heroes who exemplify courage and sound doctrine. Their lives can offer guidance and encouragement.

Reflect today on those who have influenced your faith and leadership and seek to emulate their godliness.

Discernment involves knowing when to engage and when to let go. Focusing on core truths and guarding unity preserves the health of the church.

Evaluate if your time and energy are invested in essential battles or unnecessary disputes. Seek wisdom to choose clarity and peace.
