## Devotional: Answering God's Call to Intercede for Soldiers

**Standing in the gap** is a powerful metaphor for interceding on behalf of others. In Ezekiel 22:30, God expresses His desire for someone to stand before Him to intercede and protect the land. This is our calling as prayer warriors, especially concerning the younger generation of soldiers.

## Devotional: Praying Strength and Courage Over Soldiers

Young soldiers often face fear and uncertainty, but God's Word reminds us that fear is not from Him. Joshua 1:9 commands strength and courage because God's presence goes with us wherever we go. When praying for young soldiers, we can declare these powerful promises with confidence.

2 Timothy 1:7 assures us that God's Spirit empowers believers with power, love, and self-discipline — weapons essential for the battlefield both literal and spiritual. Psalm 27:1 is a declaration of faith, encouraging us to face adversity with the assurance that God is our protector and light.

Our prayers today can lift the spirits of young soldiers, reminding them of their divine strength and courage. Encourage them, and ask God to fill their hearts with peace that conquers fear.

## Devotional: Praying Divine Peace and Hope for Soldiers

## Devotional: Empowering Young Soldiers with God's Armor
