Introduction

This event, found in Joshua 10, is a compelling testament to God's sovereignty, power, and intimate care for His people. Devotional: Trusting God's Control Over Every Situation

God's power over creation is displayed spectacularly in Joshua 10:12. Joshua's prayer for the sun and moon to stand still reveals that God controls the natural world and orchestrates events according to His will. When we face impossible situations, it is comforting to remember that the God who holds the universe in His hands is the same God working in our lives today.

This passage invites us to trust that there are no limits to what God can do. Just as He can stop the movements of heavenly bodies, He can halt the course of our struggles and grant victory. God's timing and power are perfect and reliable.

As you reflect today, consider areas where you need to surrender control and trust God's sovereign plan. Remember, His power extends beyond natural laws — He molds history for His purposes and for your good.

Devotional: Standing Firm on God's Promises

In the midst of battle, God reassures Joshua not to fear, affirming His promise that the enemy would be delivered into his hands. This reminder is a profound lesson on the importance of **faith in God's promises** even when the odds seem daunting.

Faith requires us to trust what God says rather than what we see. Joshua's courage was rooted in belief that God would fulfill His word. When we anchor ourselves in God's promises, we find strength and confidence to face obstacles, knowing that victory is assured because of His faithfulness.

Consider this: God's promises aren't distant or abstract—they are personal and active in your life today. The same God who led Joshua to victory is working for you, encouraging you to step forward without fear.

Devotional: Embracing God's Power to Perform Miracles

Miracles often occur in overwhelming situations, showing us that God's intervention can change the course of events in an instant. The sun standing still was a **miraculous extension of daylight** so Israel could complete their victory.

Just like the parted Red Sea or the feeding of the five thousand, this event reminds us that God is not limited by natural laws. He can provide beyond expectation to bring deliverance and provision.

When challenges seem insurmountable, God's miracles are still active. They may come in unexpected ways, but they show His love and power clearly. Trust that the God who parted seas stands ready to perform His wonders for you.
