Day 2: O Standing Firm in What's Right

Devotional: Be Brave and Stand for God's Ways

Daniel was known for choosing to do what was right, even when it was difficult or dangerous. When a law was made that stopped prayer, Daniel didn't hide or change his faith. Instead, he stood firm and continued praying to God three times a day. This courage came from his love for God and desire to do the right thing.

Devotional: We Can Shine Bright by Trusting God

Devotional: God's Word Guides and Strengthens Us
