#### Introduction

Through reflection, prayer, and scripture, you'll gain encouragement to stand firm and live authentically, no matter what your friends are doing.

Day 1: V Standing Firm Like Daniel

#### Devotional: Choosing Purity and Integrity No Matter the Pressure

Peer pressure can make us want to give in to things that don't align with our values, but Daniel shows us it's possible to choose what's right. In a foreign land where everyone else accepted the king's food and wine, Daniel resolved to stay pure. He didn't want his faithfulness compromised by what the crowd was doing.

When you face pressure to join in activities or behaviors that feel wrong, remember Daniel's courage. He trusted God to honor his decision and give him strength. You can do the same by praying for boldness and wisdom. The Bible promises no temptation is too great and God will help you resist.

**Integrity means saying no when it matters, even if it's hard**. Think about what truly matters to you and God's values. Saying no with respect and confidence shows you value your identity in Christ more than fitting in.

Today, reflect on areas where peer pressure challenges you. Ask God for strength to stand firm like Daniel, knowing He is with you every step.

# Devotional: Finding Boldness to Say No and Stand for Truth

**Peer pressure often silences us by making us afraid to stand out.** Yet Peter reminds us that when we put God first, we can speak boldly for what is right. Even when facing opposition, he trusted God and spoke the truth confidently.

When your friends push you to join in something that conflicts with your faith or values, it's normal to feel nervous or scared. But God promises to empower your words and give you courage. You don't have to argue harshly – but speak honestly with kindness and confidence.

Think about how you can respectfully say no and share your reasons without fear. Practice your responses, pray for boldness, and look to God to guide your words. When you act with integrity and bravery, you inspire others and demonstrate the power of faith.

Remember, standing up for what's right is not just about saying no — it's about living out your identity as a child of God with courage and love.
