- Psalm 119:9 "How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word."







#### Devotional: Being Attentive to God from Youth

Samuel's story reminds us how important it is to be sensitive and attentive to God's voice early in life. As a boy serving in the temple, Samuel was learning obedience and prayerfulness when God called him directly. His readiness to listen made all the difference. When we cultivate a heart that seeks God from a young age, our faith is rooted deeply.

Being faithful to God doesn't depend on the approval or company of others but on our commitment to respond to His call. When no one else is living for God around us, we can still choose to listen, obey, and stay on the path He sets. This requires courage and humility, but God honors those who faithfully seek Him.

Reflect on your own journey — are you making space daily to hear God's voice? Staying faithful means prioritizing His presence over peer pressure or cultural norms. Take heart that God delights when you say, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

#### Your Verse

Daniel 1:8 – "But Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine..."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Daniel 3:17–18 "If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us... But even if he does not... we will not serve your gods."
- James 1:12 "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life."







Day 2: h Facing Pressure with Courage

#### Devotional: Choosing God Over Comfort and Approval

Daniel's choice to refuse the king's food shows profound faith and commitment in the face of social and political pressure. He and his friends were young but understood that staying pure in heart and devotion to God was more important than fitting in or pleasing authority in ways that compromised their faith.

When no one else shares your values or beliefs, it can be especially challenging to stand firm. Daniel's example encourages us to make a personal resolution to honor God regardless of consequences or isolation. Courage is not the absence of fear but the decision to stand on God's promises despite it.

Are you willing to say 'no' to things that would defile your spirit? Remember that God supports and sustains those who trust Him as Daniel did. Your faithfulness may inspire others over time, and it glorifies God above all.

Day 3: Trusting God Amid Uncertainty

#### Devotional: Faith Over Fear in Tough Times

Children and young people often face fears of loneliness, rejection, and uncertainty about the future. Psalm 56 shows a heartfelt declaration to trust God despite these fears. Trusting God doesn't mean we won't face difficult emotions, but that we choose Him as our steady refuge.

When those around us reject faith or behave unfaithfully, it is natural to feel dismayed. Yet, God's promise is clear: He has good plans for you and will never leave you. Trusting Him means surrendering anxiety and embracing hope, even when the path ahead is unclear.

Let today be a reminder that your faith can blossom by trusting God in fear, drawing strength from His steadfast love. You are never truly alone, for His presence surrounds you always.

- 1 Corinthians 10:13 'No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind... God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear...'







#### Devotional: Integrity Shines When Alone

**Integrity means living honestly and morally upright even when nobody is watching.** For children and young believers, this can be difficult when peer influences or environments encourage compromise. Yet, God honors those who choose integrity because it reflects His character.

Remember, your security in life does not rest on popularity or approval but on walking in integrity. Even when you stand alone in your convictions, God's faithfulness surrounds and strengthens you. Temptations are real, but God equips you to overcome.

Commit today to walking blamelessly and righteously before God. Your example can be a light to others and bring eternal rewards.

Day 5: F Growing in Wisdom Daily

#### Devotional: Seeking God's Wisdom in All Circumstances

Even children can grow in wisdom by seeking God's guidance daily. Wisdom isn't just about knowledge but about applying God's truth in decisions and challenges. When no one else seems to follow God's ways, asking for His wisdom equips you to make choices that honor Him.

King Solomon famously asked God for wisdom, and that same invitation stands open to us. God's Spirit imparts understanding and discernment to help us navigate life's complexities and stand firm in faith.

Commit to prayerfully seeking God's wisdom each day. Read His Word and be intentional about learning from His truths. As you grow in wisdom, you reflect God's character more clearly and influence others positively.

#### Devotional: The Eternal Reward of Steadfast Faith
