Isaiah 41:10 - "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."
- Philippians 4:13 "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."







Day 1: ① God's Strength When You're Vulnerable

Devotional: Finding Strength Through God's Presence

Feeling vulnerable and anxious is natural during deployment seasons.

Uncertainty can weigh heavily on your heart, but *God assures you that He is your strength and helper.* **Isaiah 41:10** reminds us not to fear because God is always near, ready to uphold us with His righteous hand.

In the midst of waiting and unpredictable circumstances, you may feel powerless. Yet, God's power is made perfect in your weakness. The military lifestyle often demands resilience and courage beyond what feels possible. Leaning on God renews your strength daily.

Remember, **Psalm 46:1** calls God our refuge in trouble. When questions and fear try to crowd your mind, seek refuge in Him through prayer and Scripture. Let His presence calm your heart.

Take heart in the truth that you are not facing your battles alone. Every moment of loneliness or uncertainty is met with God's sustaining grace. His strength empowers you to stand firm, encourages you when you are weary, and sustains you through every challenge.

Devotional: Exchanging Anxiety for God's Peace

Periods of separation during deployment often bring anxious thoughts and sleepless nights. Yet, God calls you to exchange anxiety for His peace—a peace unlike any the world offers.

Philippians 4:6-7

Thanksgiving plays a vital role here—it shifts your focus to God's faithfulness and provision, cultivating gratitude even in hardship. As a military wife, you face unique challenges, but God's peace remains accessible when you take your burdens to Him continuously.

Jesus promised in **John 14:27** that His peace would calm troubled hearts and remove fear. When the unknown looms, intentionally invite Jesus' peace to fill your heart and mind, replacing worry with His perfect calm.

Deuteronomy 31:6 challenges you to be strong and courageous, grounded in God's promise never to abandon you. Take heart today by resting in His steadfast companionship.

Devotional: Renewing Strength by Hoping in the Lord

Isaiah 40:31

Joy rooted in the Lord fuels your inner reserves, as Nehemiah 8:10 reminds us, and even when your body grows tired, God remains your unwavering strength.

Devotional: Living Confidently in God's Design

Military wives often wear many hats and face unique pressures, but your worth and dignity come from God. Proverbs 31:25

God designed you with intention and care, as Psalm 139:14 recalls—you are fearfully and wonderfully made. This truth anchors your identity beyond circumstances and roles.

Recognize that God's grace is enough, especially when you feel weak or overwhelmed. **2 Corinthians 12:9**

As this study concludes, take time to rest your soul deeply in God's loving presence. Psalm 62:5-6

Jesus personally extends an invitation in *Matthew 11:28* to all who are weary —offering genuine rest beyond physical relief. Let yourself receive this grace fully today.

The foundation of your peace and security springs from God's boundless love, just as Jesus loves you profoundly in John 15:9. **Remain in that love.** It nurtures strength and peace that transcend circumstances.

Whatever your journey as a military wife has been so far, God's presence is your eternal refuge. Rest in His love, and face the future with confidence and hope.
