- Hebrews 12:11 "No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it."
- Proverbs 12:1 "Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge."







Devotional: The Role of Self-Control in Purity

Self-discipline is essential to maintaining sexual purity and spiritual health. Paul's metaphor of disciplining the body highlights intentionality and ongoing effort.

Though discipline can be uncomfortable, it produces long-term peace and righteousness. It also reflects love for knowledge and growth in God.
